Schedule L, Part IV, Business Transactions Involving Interested Persons	Royalties paid to Dr Robert C Sproul - The Organization is party to several licensing agreements with the Organization's Chairman related to its publishing activities, requiring the Organization to make annual royalty payments ranging from 10% to 12% of related net sales of the published items. In connection with these agreements, the Organization paid its Chairman \$90,951 during 2015. As of December 31, 2015, \$103,423 of short-term royalties were payable to Dr. Sproul. Such royalties are typically paid within 60 days of year-end (to allow time for the Organization to calculate the amount due) and are included in accrued expenses at Part X, Line 17. The Organization has similar agreements in place with a number of unrelated parties. The royalty percentages paid to the Chairman are significantly lower than the percentages paid by the Organization to unrelated parties pursuant to similar agreements. The payments made under terms of the Chairman's royalty agreements with the Organization are significantly less than those made pursuant to terms offered to the Chairman under comparable industry royalty agreements from nonaffiliated publishers.
