Ten scholarships of up to \$10,000 each will be awarded to eligible graduate and undergraduate students who are poised to make a significant contribution to the field of conservation. Scholarship funds may be used to cover students' expenses for tuition, fees, books, room and board and other direct expenses related to their studies. Awards will be made based on merit and will take into consideration that student's academic achievements and their ability and commitment to develop innovative solutions that are designed to address real and pressing issues affecting fish, wildlife and plant conservation efforts.</p> <p>Objective To identify 10 scholarship recipients who are well-qualified and deserving of the award based on the following criteria, and who collectively represent a diversity of academic and professional interests in the field of conservation.</p> <p>Criteria 1) Knowledge of conservation issues, 2) Merits of research/study proposal based on its - Significance to conservation field - Feasibility and - Overall quality, 3) Innovativeness of the research/study, 4) Academic achievements, and 5) Commitment to leadership in conservation field. These criteria are not intended to be applied on an equivalent basis, rather, the objective is to consider the criteria in assessing the relative strengths of each candidate with respect to their ability and commitment to develop innovative solutions to significant fish, wildlife, and plant conservation issues.</p> <p>Rich Guadagno Memorial Scholarship Fund The Scholarship The Rich Guadagno Memorial Wildlife/Natural Resources Scholarship Fund provides three scholarships a year for natural resources students attending Humboldt State University and the College of the Redwoods in California who are interested in working with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service at the Humboldt Bay National Wildlife Refuge and surrounding areas on research projects. The scholarship program was established by the Foundation to honor the memory of Rich Guadagno, who died in the crash of Flight 93 on 9/11/2001. He served as a U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Refuge Manager at Humboldt Bay Refuge in California, and worked as staff at other refuges around the country. He was a committed conservation professional and exceptional human being who was very interested in encouraging young people to choose conservation as their careers. The Purpose of the Scholarship The scholarship fund is aimed at achieving three goals. First, it would link the Refuge more closely with the University, connecting students with refuge biologists that would help them with research projects where data are needed on or around the Refuge. Second, it would also link the Refuge more closely with the local communities by involving the College of the Redwoods (a Community College), Rotary Clubs, Chamber of Commerce and others who may wish to be involved in this project. These were both very important goals of Rich's when he worked at the refuge. Finally, and most importantly, it would memorialize Rich by inspiring young students to pursue their passion in conservation, something Rich had an abundance of and which we think would be a tribute worthy of Rich.</p> <p>Description of the Scholarship Fund Three scholarships each year are awarded for at least the next 10 years (depending on fund availability) - One \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student at the College of the Redwoods Community College, located across the road from the Refuge to assist freshmen or sophomores in pursuing conservation studies - A second \$1000 scholarship is awarded to a senior at Humboldt State University for them to conduct their senior thesis project - A third \$2000 scholarship/grant is awarded to a graduate student to work on their Master's Degree research. These scholarships will contribute to the student's tuition or other material costs. Who would be eligible to apply Students who are interested in a career in natural resources management and have a good grade point average in sciences (2.75 or higher) will be encouraged to apply. They will also be given extra bonus points if they have already volunteered for some community service. The senior and graduate school applicants will need to propose a research project that they will conduct at the Refuge or surrounding area as part of the application process. The applicants need to demonstrate their commitment to conservation, submit a written essay about their interests and a proposal describing their research project, as well as two letters of reference, and their transcripts. If awarded, they will conduct the work and submit a report to the Foundation and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and will be required to make a presentation at the community level.</p> <p>How the information is disseminated/application process Posters/descriptions announcing the scholarship opportunity are available at the Financial Aid Departments of the University and College. The Foundation and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service will post it on our websites along with the application form. The Service will be the single point of contact to collect the applications, copy them and submit to the Foundation and Selection Committee to streamline the process. Applications will be due by the end of November of each year. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service host a "Scholarship Orientation Day" at the Refuge for those wishing to apply. Potential applicants visit the Refuge on the orientation day, learn about the Refuge and its resources and some of the Refuge's research needs, and be able to ask questions about how to apply for the scholarship. Refuge staff will be available to answer these questions and perhaps lead some tours/walks through the Refuge.</p> <p>Selection Process The Selection Committee has the following representatives - National Fish and Wildlife Foundation - U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service - Humboldt State University - College of the Redwoods - Chamber of Commerce or other community supporter - Member of the Guadagno family. The selection committee meets each year around January to review the applications. Successful applicants will be awarded their scholarships in February prior to end of the school year.</p> <p>Funds management and fundraising Rich's Conservation Fund at the Foundation currently has a balance of about \$60,000 from donations made over the past two years and the Foundation's federal funds. Additional donations to the scholarship fund will occur over time. In addition to soliciting applications for research benefiting any of the 545 National Wildlife Refuges, we are seeking applications that focus on the National Wildlife Refuges that serve as "Land Management Research and Demonstration" (LMRD) areas. The LMRD areas have been established to showcase successful management techniques and to develop and validate new techniques through applied research. The list of fully established LMRD refuges includes Hanford Reach National Monument/Saddle Mountain NWR, Washington, Bosque del Apache NWR, New Mexico, Neal Smith NWR, Iowa, Rachel Carson/Parker River NWRs, Maine and Massachusetts, and National Bison Range/National Elk Refuge, Montana and Wyoming.
