More specifically, but without limitation, the purpose of the Association is the promotion of scientific, educational, historical and interpretative activities of the National Park Service including scientific research, investigation and experimentation, and to serve as the primary fund raising entity for Grand Canyon National Park, "GCNP". All operations of the Association within Grand Canyon National Park shall conform with the applicable guidelines and standards issued by the National Park Service for Cooperating Associations.

#### ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall have no power or authority to do any act for the personal profit or pecuniary gain of any of its members or directors or officers, nor do any act which would remove it from its status as a non-profit and tax exempt-corporation. The corporation shall have no capital stock and shall be composed of members rather than stockholders.

#### ARTICLE V

Membership in the corporation shall be open to those natural persons interested in achieving the purposes of the corporation as set forth herein and in the bylaws and who contribute financially to the support of the corporation in at least the minimum amount as set periodically by the Board of Directors.

#### ARTICLE VI

The name and address of the statutory agent of the corporation is Susan E. Schroeder.

#### ARTICLE VII

The current place of business of the corporation is Grand Canyon, Arizona.

#### ARTICLE VIII

The board of directors shall initially consist of nine (9) directors. The number of directors may be changed as provided in the bylaws. No director shall be a National Park Service employee.

#### ARTICLE IX

The term and manner of election of directors shall be set forth in the bylaws.

#### ARTICLE X

The corporation shall indemnify its directors, officers, agents, employees, committee members and volunteers to the fullest extent permissible under Arizona law.

ARTICLE XI

A director of the corporation shall not be personally liable to the corporation or its members for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director unless such acts constitute intentional misconduct, knowing violation of law, or conflict of interest.

ARTICLE XII

In the event of the dissolution of the Association, all properties and assets controlled by the Association shall be transferred to the Grand Canyon National Park Service in accordance with the National Park Service's directives, as amended, supplemented, or superseded, and in a manner appropriate to the Association's established objectives, subject to the provisions of Arizona's Non-profit Corporation Law and provisions governing the disposition of assets of organizations which qualify under Section 501(C)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and subsequent amendments thereto. The foregoing restated Articles of Incorporation correctly set forth without change the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation as amended.

## **CODE OF ETHICS AND CONFLICT OF INTEREST**

In a belief that it is appropriate for this Association to have a code of ethics with respect to relationships between Grand Canyon Association Board (Board) members and the Grand Canyon Association (Association) and further to deal with the possibility or perception of conflicts of interest that might arise from time to time, the Board adopts the following policy:

1. **Code of Ethics:** Elected or appointed members of the Board of Directors have the responsibility to maintain high ethical standards as they govern the organization and therefore have the obligation to do so through organized, skillful, unbiased and courteous service.
2. **Conflict of Interest:** The Board recognizes that it is in the interest of the Association to avoid actual or perceived conflicts of interest with respect to professional and business interests of members of the Board in transactions that might occur with the Association. However, the Board also recognizes that members may present unique qualifications that argue affirmatively for provision of such services.

If a member of the Board provides professional or business services to the Association, the matter shall be fully disclosed at a meeting of the Board prior to the initiation of such a relationship and the relationship maintained and documented to be as nearly arms-length as the circumstances may allow. This may include, but not be limited to, documentation of the market value of the work performed as well as the unique considerations that demand a compensated

relationship between a Board member and the Association. The affected Board member shall not participate or be present for any discussions or vote.

Board members maintaining no such relationships will attest to that fact in writing on an annual basis and agree to notify the Board should their status change.
