

Alabama Power Foundation Scholarship Program

Eligibility

For the Presidential Scholarship and The Alabama Power Foundation Vocational/Technical Scholarships, only high school seniors are eligible to apply. For the Alabama Power Foundation Scholarships, high school seniors, college freshmen, sophomores and juniors are eligible to apply. Applicants for all awards must be dependent children (including stepchildren) of

- Full-time employees of APCO who have been employed for at least one year as of January 1 of the year in which the awards are granted. Employees must still be employed at the time the winners are announced.
- Deceased employees of APCO who were employed for at least one year and were employed by the company at the time of death.
- Retired employees who are presently in pay status on the APCO monthly retirement payroll.

Definition of dependent children: a son or daughter declared as an exemption for income tax purposes under the rules and regulations established by the Internal Revenue Service.

Awards

Presidential Scholarship: One Presidential Scholarship is awarded each year to the high school senior who presents the most impressive combination of academic achievement, participation in extracurricular and community activities, and leadership qualities with financial need. The amount of this four-year award is the tuition and mandatory fees at any four-year accredited non-profit public college or university within the state of Alabama.

Alabama Power Foundation Scholarships: These scholarships are in the amount of \$1,250, and are based on financial need of at least \$1,250. They are renewable for up to three years. Once awarded, a recipient must show satisfactory academic progress and continued dependency status in order for an award to be renewed. Funds are to be applied to tuition, fees, books, or supplies required for course load at any four-year accredited non-profit college or university.

Alabama Power Vocational/Technical Scholarships: These scholarships are awarded to applicants who can demonstrate financial need of at least \$1,250, and who plan to major in vocational/technical programs that usually require one or two years to complete. Therefore, technical scholarships are awarded only to high school seniors, and are renewable for only one additional year. Funds are to be applied to tuition, fees, books, or supplies required for course load at any two-year accredited non-profit vocational/technical institution.

Winner Selection

A Selection Committee comprised of educators unassociated with Alabama Power Company will evaluate applications and select the winners based on academic achievements, community involvement, and financial need. This independent committee is designed to ensure impartiality and the confidentiality of the selection process.

Using Login Option 2, enter your access key (ALPR), Applicant Identification Number (AIN) and name to re-enter the application process. Scholarship recipients are responsible for delivering their scholarship checks to the proper office at their institution.

Payment of Funds

Checks will be mailed to each recipient's mailing address and will be made payable to the institution only. Checks will be issued in August. It is the recipient's responsibility to notify ISTS should the award check not arrive on or about 30 days from the issue date.

Program Administration

To assure complete impartiality in selection of winners and to maintain a high level of professionalism, the program is administered by International Scholarship and Tuition Services, Inc., an independent firm that specializes in managing sponsored scholarship programs.
