HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES HELPED 572 CLIENTS ACCESS MORE THAN \$2.5 MILLION IN IN-HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SUPPORT SERVICES AFTER A COMPREHENSIVE IN-HOME ASSESSMENT, EACH CLIENT RECEIVES A CUSTOMIZED CARE PLAN TO ADDRESS THEIR INDIVIDUAL NEEDS. SOME OF THE SERVICES PROVIDED INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING: 1,085 HOURS OF COMPANION SUPPORT, 46,222 HOURS OF IN-FACILITY RESPITE AND 19,139 HOURS OF IN-HOME RESPITE, 23,414 HOURS OF LIGHT HOUSEKEEPING ASSISTANCE, 19,661 HOURS OF ASSISTANCE WITH DAILY LIVING ACTIVITIES, \$127,329 IN CONSUMABLE MEDICAL SUPPLIES. WITH THIS HELP, 97% OF THE CLIENTS SERVED WERE ABLE TO REMAIN AT HOME, THUS AVOIDING NURSING HOME PLACEMENT.

HOT NUTRITIOUS MEALS WERE SERVED TO 1,974 SENIORS RECEIVING MEALS ON WHEELS OR ATTENDING ONE OF 11 NEIGHBORHOOD SENIORS AT LUNCH MEAL SITES. THIS SEVENTH ANNUAL EVENT TARGETS VOLUNTEER RECRUITMENT AND FOOD AVAILABILITY TO SENIORS "SO NO SENIOR GOES HUNGRY".

LICENSE# 229484 ONE-HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT (168) SENIORS RECEIVED 13,202 HOURS OF ASSISTANCE WITH LIGHT HOUSEKEEPING, SHOPPING AND MEAL PREPARATION. NINETY-FIVE (95) SENIORS RECEIVED 8,925 HOURS OF ASSISTANCE WITH PERSONAL CARE. FORTY-EIGHT (48) CAREGIVERS WERE PROVIDED 6,749 HOURS OF RESPITE RELIEF. NINETEEN (19) SENIORS RECEIVED 2,412 HOURS OF COMPANIONSHIP TO PREVENT SOCIAL ISOLATION AND LONELINESS. THE BREVARD COMMUNITY KITCHEN PREPARES FRESHLY COOKED MEALS FOR THE FRAILEST OF BREVARD'S CITIZENS, ITS ELDERLY AND AT-RISK CHILDREN. THE KITCHEN PREPARED AND DELIVERED 385,197 MEALS FOR MEALS ON WHEELS RECIPIENTS, SENIORS AT LUNCH ATTENDEES, ADULT DAY CARE, CENTER ATTENDEES, CHILDREN ATTENDING CHILDCARE PROGRAMS, AND SCHOOLS. THE FOLLOWING ARE SHORT-TERM OR SEASONAL FOOD CENTERED EVENTS: THE SATURDAY MEALS ON WHEELS PROJECT IS A PARTNERSHIP WITH UNITED WAY OF BREVARD AND LOCAL CORPORATIONS. CORPORATE EMPLOYEES DELIVERED 925 MEALS ON 10 SATURDAYS. MEAL RECIPIENTS WOULD OTHERWISE NOT RECEIVE WEEKEND NOURISHMENT. THE KITCHEN SERVED 25,355 MEALS TO LOW-INCOME CHILDREN ATTENDING BREVARD COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION SUMMER LUNCH PROGRAM. THE KITCHEN CATERED 46 VARIOUS FUNCTIONS AND PROVIDED 3,827 MEALS. THE SENIORS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SUPPORTS AT-RISK SENIORS IN THE EARLY STAGES OF DIFFICULTY. THE HOME IMPROVEMENT TEAM WORKED 7,670 HOURS INSTALLING GRAB BARS, BUILDING ACCESS RAMPS, AND COMPLETING MINOR HOME REPAIRS HELPING 1,504 SENIORS LIVE SAFELY IN THEIR OWN HOMES. SCREENING AND ASSESSMENT SERVICES HELPED 110 CLIENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES OBTAIN 4,157 HOURS OF HELP WITH LIGHT HOUSEKEEPING AND RESPITE RELIEF. BREVARD COUNTY LEGAL AID HELPED 267 SENIORS WITH CIVIL MATTERS SUCH AS PROTECTION AGAINST FORECLOSURE, GUIDANCE WITH LANDLORD-TENANT ISSUES, PROTECTION FROM CONSUMER FRAUD, AND ASSISTANCE WITH ADVANCED DIRECTIVES. TWO-HUNDRED AND FIVE (205) SENIORS RECEIVED 24,460 TRANSPORTATION TRIPS TO IMPORTANT APPOINTMENTS OR TO SENIORS AT LUNCH SITES. THE SENIOR TRANSERVE PROGRAM RECRUITS VOLUNTEER DRIVERS WHO USE THEIR OWN VEHICLES TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION FOR AMBULATORY, NON-DRIVING, HOME BOUND SENIORS WHO NEED A RIDE TO MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS, GROCERY SHOPPING, SOCIAL ACTIVITIES, VOLUNTEERING OR OTHER APPOINTMENTS. SIXTY-SEVEN (67) DEDICATED VOLUNTEERS TRAVELED 44,626 MILES, AND TWENTY-SEVEN (27) VETS DRIVING VETS VOLUNTEER DRIVERS TRAVELED 18,916 MILES USING THEIR OWN TIME, VEHICLES AND FUEL TO TRANSPORT 240 UNDUPLICATED, NON-DRIVING SENIOR AND VETERAN CLIENTS. TRANSPORTATION INCLUDES VISITS TO MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS, REHABILITATION FACILITIES, HOSPITALS, PHARMACIES, GROCERY STORES, BEAUTY AND BARBER SHOPS, THE VA CLINIC AND OTHER IMPORTANT APPOINTMENTS. TWENTY-FIVE (25) SENIOR DRIVERS WERE GIVEN FREE CARFIT EVALUATIONS TO ENSURE SAFE DRIVING PRACTICES. THE SUNFLOWER HOUSE IS A TWO-FOLD PROGRAM PROVIDING CAREGIVER SUPPORT THROUGH EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND RESPITE AND A SENIOR GATHERING SPOT, PROVIDING A PLACE TO MEET NEW FRIENDS WHILE ENJOYING EDUCATIONAL, RECREATIONAL AND SOCIAL EXPERIENCES. SEVEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE (775) INDIVIDUALS RECEIVED INFORMATION ON COMMUNITY RESOURCES. EDUCATION ON AGENCY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES WAS PROVIDED AT 124 HEALTH FAIRS, COMMUNITY EVENTS, AND PRESENTATIONS TO COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS AND CLUBS. TWENTY (20) VOLUNTEERS DONATED 4,985 HOURS OF SERVICE ANSWERING PHONE CALLS AND PROVIDING INFORMATION AND REFERRALS TO SENIORS AND THEIR CAREGIVERS. SEVENTY (70) SENIORS PARTICIPATED IN 97 HOURS OF CLASSES INVOLVING CHAIR EXERCISE, WEIGHT LIFTING AND RANGE OF MOTION EXERCISE. THE CAREGIVER SUPPORT PROGRAM ASSISTED 62 CAREGIVERS IN CARING FOR THEIR ELDERLY LOVED ONES THROUGH THE PROVISION OF 700 HOURS OF CARE MANAGEMENT COORDINATION. CAREGIVERS AND THEIR FAMILIES RECEIVED 2,267 HOURS OF IN-HOME RESPITE CARE AND 7,406 HOURS OF ADULT DAYCARE. THE GRANDPARENTING AGAIN PROGRAM PROVIDED SUPPORTIVE SERVICES TO 15 GRANDPARENTS WHO ARE PRIMARY CAREGIVERS FOR 45 MINOR RELATIVE CHILDREN THROUGH THE PROVISION OF 51 HOURS OF CARE MANAGEMENT COORDINATION. SENIORS AND GRANDPARENTS RECEIVED 63 HOURS OF INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP GERONTOLOGICAL COUNSELING TO HELP THEM WORK THROUGH MENTAL, EMOTIONAL, AND SOCIAL ADJUSTMENT ISSUES RELATED TO THE AGING PROCESS. FAMILY CAREGIVERS RECEIVED ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-FIVE (145) HOURS OF CAREGIVER TRAINING AND SUPPORT, WHICH INCLUDES SUPPORT FOR CAREGIVERS CARING FOR FAMILY MEMBERS WITH DEMENTIA, SUPPORT THROUGH THE BEREAVEMENT PROCESS, AND SUPPORT FOR CAREGIVERS TRANSITIONING TO A LIFE BEYOND CAREGIVING. CONSUMABLE MEDICAL SUPPLIES TOTALING \$22,368 WERE PROVIDED TO CAREGIVERS AND SENIORS, WHILE THE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT BANK DISTRIBUTED 200 WHEELCHAIRS, WALKERS, CANES, BEDSIDE COMMUNES, AND SHOWER CHAIRS. THE RETIRED AND SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM (RSVP) IDENTIFIES NEEDS IN THE COMMUNITY AND ENGAGES SENIORS FIFTY-FIVE AND OLDER INTO VOLUNTEER SERVICE. SENIORS CHOOSE FROM A VARIETY OF COMMUNITY SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES TO SHARE THEIR EXPERIENCES. THREE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (385) VOLUNTEERS AGED 55 AND OLDER PROVIDED 48,522 HOURS OF SERVICE VALUED AT \$914,640. RSVP VOLUNTEERS WERE RECRUITED TO HELP SUPPORT 41 NOT-FOR-PROFIT AND GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES. VOLUNTEER STATIONS OR PLACEMENT SITES INCLUDE SENIOR CENTERS, SHARING CENTERS, VETERAN'S PROGRAMS, PUBLIC SCHOOLS, THE BREVARD COMMUNITY KITCHEN, THE STATE ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, AND THE SUNFLOWER HOUSE. SEVENTY PERCENT (70%) OF VOLUNTEERS ARE PLACED IN PROGRAMS THAT ARE FOCUSED ON HEALTHY FUTURES, EDUCATION, VETERAN AND MILITARY FAMILIES, ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY, AND CAPACITY BUILDING.
