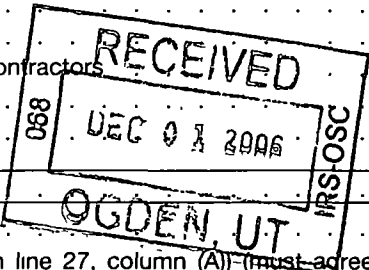



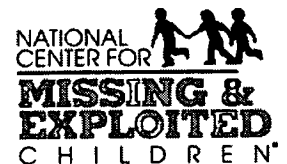
Age Progression By NCMEC
