**ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO  
AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF  
BREVARD COUNTY POLICE ATHLETIC LEAGUE, INC.**

The undersigned, being the President of Brevard County Police Athletic League, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation and pursuant to §617.1006, Florida Statutes, hereby adopts the following amendment to its Articles of Incorporation and certifies to the Secretary of State as follows:

**ARTICLE I**

The name of the corporation is Brevard County Police Athletic League, Inc. (hereafter, the "Corporation") and the Document Number assigned to the Corporation is N97000002404. The Corporation filed Amended Articles of Incorporation on May 18, 2011, and the Corporation now seeks to once again amend the Articles of Incorporation to institute a name change.

**ARTICLE II**

The text of the Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation shall be as follows:

Article I of the Amended Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation shall be further amended to read as follows:

**ARTICLE I**

The name of this Corporation shall be: "Brevard County Sheriff's Office Police Athletic League, Inc."

**ARTICLE III**

The Amendment to the Amended Articles of Incorporation referred to in Article II hereof was duly and legally adopted by the Members and the Board of Directors by Resolution on March 5, 2013, pursuant to §617.1006, Florida Statutes.
